



Updated Health and Safety Plan for BSW Summer Camp

Here are the updates for camp and keeping everyone in the communication loop as regulations shift heading into summer. The following is to help families understand the precautions being taken and implemented for summer camp this year and having an open channel of communication between BSW and our community. As regulations change and we move forward during another historic year we will update this document.

- All camps and locations have capped numbers (lower than previous years).
- All locations will have a drop-off/pick-up line. One of our team members will escort children to and from parent cars.
- Students will also be spread out as much as possible. We have already lowered the cap for all sessions to keep this possible.
- Masks – Everyone is required to wear a mask when indoors.
- Friday ceremony – On Friday afternoon we will host a brief outdoor, socially distanced closing ceremony to cap off the week.
- Following a schedule for routine cleaning and disinfection.
- We have a strict stay home policy when ill. Please take your young wizard's temperature at home before coming in each morning.
- All professors are being trained on the health and safety protocols as outlined by the CDC.
- Health related questions will be asked each morning at drop-off.
